Services	Explanations and Providers
Amputee Rehabilitation / Limb fitting service	Specialist rehabilitation programme for patients that have undergone amputation surgery or have suffered congenital limb loss and require an artificial limb (SSOTP)
Bone densitometry (DEXA)	Diagnosis and treatment of osteoporosis and other metabolic bone diseases (SSOTP)
Daycase Unit	Rheumatology and rehabilitation medicine day case procedures; ultrasound and blood transfusion service (SSOTP)
Diagnostics	X-ray and Ultrasound facilities (UHNM)
DVT Clinic	Deep Vein Thrombosis clinic (UHNM)
Fracture Liaison Service	Nurse led fracture case-finding, assessment and performance of diagnostic evaluations for the secondary prevention of osteoporotic fractures. (SSOTP)
Heart Failure	Nurse led clinics to support appropriate medical management or for patients experiencing complex symptoms (SSOTP)
Impact Pain Management	Pain management clinics & assessments (SSOTP)
Musculoskeletal Interface Service (MIS)	A one stop musculoskeletal assessment and treatment service for management of a broad range of non-surgical musculoskeletal conditions. (SSOTP)
Obstetric Ultrasound	Ultrasound clinic as part of the ante-natal care pathway (UHNM)
Occupational Therapy	Occupational Therapy for rheumatology, musculoskeletal, stroke and rehabilitation patients (SSOTP)
Orthopaedic	Consultant led orthopaedic follow up clinics. (UHNM)
Pharmacy	SSOTP
Phlebotomy	Blood testing (UHNM)
Physiotherapy	Outpatient physiotherapy for rheumatology, musculoskeletal, stroke and rehabilitation patients (SSOTP)
Podiatry	Community-based specialist foot care service providing specialist and clinical interventions ranging from health education and promotion to assessment, diagnosis and treatment of foot problems. (SSOTP)

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Rehabilitation Medicine	Outpatient consultant and nurse clinics for patients with a diverse range of disabilities, for example, acquired brain injury, multiple trauma, multiple sclerosis and other neurological problems. (SSOTP)
Rheumatology	Hub for the Rheumatology service. Outpatient consultant, nurse and therapy led clinics for patients with arthritis / joint disorders; rheumatology blood monitoring. (SSOTP)
Walk in Centre	Nurse-led facility that provides assessment, treatment and advice for minor injuries and illnesses (SSOTP)

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
