Services You Suggested

From the last event and CHAD analysis of data a core offer for each site has emerged.

- **Walk in centre**
- **Minor Injuries Unit**
- **Out of Hours**
- Extended skill mix i.e. GP led – prescribing – ANP
- **Outpatients** – Current provision plus tailored services based on local needs
- **Beds** – slightly differing provision by site
- **Diagnostics** – X-ray – Ultrasound – ECG
- **Mental Health** – crisis care, counselling , day care
- **Dementia Services** – ranging from memory clinic to Centre of Excellence
- **Phlebotomy** – based on required demand in each locality.
- **Hub** - wellbeing - voluntary sector - social prescribing - Care navigators
- **GP Services** – Differing provision by site
